WHEREAS, the People With Disabilities Foundation (PWDF) is a San Francisco-based, nonprofit organization, dedicated to providing education and advocacy for people with psychiatric and physical disabilities; and

WHEREAS, since its founding eight years ago, the PWDF has helped to provide legal representation for disabled persons in cases against the Social Security Administration and under the American with Disabilities Act of 1990; and

WHEREAS, the PWDF puts on free public seminars to educate the public, as well as employers, about coping skills and sensitivity training; and

WHEREAS, the PWDF has produced a new training video *Understanding Employees and Job Applicants with Psychiatric Disabilities* that will be publicly premiered at the Mission Campus of City College of San Francisco today; and

WHEREAS, this video is designed for the general public, employers, employees, and agencies who need to know and understand the nature of these disorders, and also to show employers how they can successfully employ people with psychological disorders; and

WHEREAS, our City fully supports the message of equality and understanding within the workplace; now
