- Emotional- Anxiety, Panic Attacks, Depression
- Cognitive Function- Impulsive, Diminished Ability to Maintain Linear Thought Patterns
- Relinquished Power of Attorney

First Therapeutic Animal




Yoda

Steps We Took	Landlords Stance
Researched Laws on Therapeutic Animals	Continued Leaving 3-Day Notices on the Door
Steps We Took	Landlords Stance
Discussion with Primary Care Doctor & Obtained a Note	Initially Rejected the Note
Steps We Took	Landlords Stance
Provided Education on Therapeutic Animals to Landlord	Accepted Note

*At this Point, I had an in Depth Conversation with the Landlord Regarding My Mother's Condition, the Fact I am Her Power of Attorney, and that All Communications Regarding Concerns Should be Directed Through Me as They Confuse and Upset My Mother and this Affects Her Well Being

Landlords Stance	Steps We Took
Contacted Me & Threatened Eviction	Researched Laws on Companion Animals
Landlords Stance	Steps We Took
Stated My Mother Already Had a Therapeutic Animal	Discussion with Primary Care Doctor & Obtained an Additional Note Stating Different Reasoning for the New Animal
Landlords Stance	Steps We Took
Accepted the Second Note	Provided Landlord with Additional Education on the Difference Between Therapeutic & Companion Animals
