Instead of being closed on the basis of Investigated and Dismissed – Insufficient Evidence, the official Department of Fair Employment and Housing (DFEH) record will reflect that your case has been closed as Agency Discretion.

This action is being taken because DFEH received an appeal to the closure determination in the above-referenced matter. After careful review of the case file, DFEH determined that there was sufficient evidence to support all or some of the allegation(s) set forth in the complaint; however, due to the unresponsiveness of the respondents, DFEH was unable to refer this case to its Dispute Resolution Division for voluntary mediation and therefore, DFEH has no other recourse than to close the case.
